How to find your classroom

1. Check the timetable to see which building your class is. (Use cheat sheet above) ex. BB 1-52

2. Each building room starts with the floor in which the room is located.

For instance, if the room number begins with:

- **0** Basement floor
- 1 First floor
- 2 Second floor
- 3 Third floor
- 4 Fourth floor etc

3. When you arrive on the floor, written in front of each door is the exact room number. Check each door to find your classroom.

NOTE: Some classrooms do not have room numbers. They have room names instead. For instance, ROWE THEATRE (TH.ROW), THEATRE A (TH. A), THEATRE B (TH. B) etc
